RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE FEASIBILITY OF HOSTING THE SUMMER OLYMPICS.

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of 3 members  
2 of the senate, 1 to be appointed by the minority leader, 3 members  
3 of the house of representatives, 1 to be appointed by the minority  
4 leader and 3 members to be appointed by the governor is hereby  
5 established for the purpose of making an investigation and study  
6 relative to the feasibility of bidding for a future summer  
7 Olympics. Said investigation and study shall include but not be  
8 limited to the prospects of working with other New England states  
9 and should seek input from local governments especially in our  
10 larger cities and other organizations and agencies.

11     Said commission shall report to the General Court the results of  
12 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,  
13 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-  
14 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the  
15 house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of  
16 December, 2007.
