AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY KNOWN AS THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN TO
GRANT AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF WINES AND MALT
BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the
2 General Laws, the town Council of the town of Franklin may
3 grant 1 additional license for the sale of wines and malt beverages
4 not to be drunk on the premises under section 15 of said chapter
5 138 to Lincoln Street Market, Inc. The License shall be subject to
6 all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

1 SECTION 2. The issuance of said license shall be within the
2 sound discretion of the town Council of the town of Franklin.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
