AN ACT REQUIRING TRACKING SUBJECTS IN SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following
- 3 sentence:—
- 4 In all public high schools courses on the bible and international
- 5 religions shall be taught as required subjects for the purpose of pro-
- 6 moting morality and brotherhood.
