AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW PROVIDING INCENTIVES TO THE MOTION PICTURE INDUSTRY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 inserting after the word “video”, in line 401, the following  
4 words:— digital media project,

1 SECTION 2. Said section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws,  
2 as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line  
3 442, the number “20” and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 number:— 25

1 SECTION 3. Said section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws,  
2 as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines  
3 481 through 483, inclusive, the following words: “(6) The total  
4 amount of tax credits provided under this subsection in connection  
5 with any one motion picture production shall not exceed  
6 \$7,000,000.”

1 SECTION 4. Section 38T of chapter 63 of the General Laws, as  
2 so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the word  
3 “video”, in line 14, the following words:— digital media project

1 SECTION 5. Said section 38T of chapter 63 of the General  
2 Laws, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out,  
3 in line 55, the number “20” and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following number:— 25

1 SECTION 6. Said section 38T of chapter 63 of the General  
2 Laws, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out  
3 subsection (f).

1 SECTION 7. Section 1 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as  
2 so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the word  
3 “video”, in line 50 the following words:— digital media project

1 SECTION 8. Section 6 of said chapter 64H of the General  
2 Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended, in line 576, by striking  
3 out the figure “\$250,000” and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following figure:— \$50,000

1 SECTION 9. Said section 6 of chapter 64H of the General  
2 Laws, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out,  
3 in line 592, the figure “\$250,000” and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following figure:— \$50,000

1 SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, the commissioner of revenue shall annually, not later  
3 than December 31, report in writing to the house and senate com-  
4 mittees on ways and means on the status of the film tax credit  
5 established pursuant to section 6 of chapter 62, section 38T of  
6 chapter 63 and section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws. Said  
7 report shall include, but not be limited to, the motion picture pro-  
8 duction activity generated by said tax credits and the net revenue  
9 impact of said tax credits.
