AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELECTION IN THE CITY OF EVERETT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 of Chapter 355 of the acts of 1892 is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following sentence:—
- 3 An individual running for elective office shall have his name on
- 4 the ballot only for one office that is one seat at any one election.
