AN ACT EXEMPTING ALL POSITIONS IN THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, all positions in the department of public
3 works in the town of Franklin shall be exempt from Chapter 31 of
4 the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall not impair the civil service status of
2 any person holding a position in the department of public works on
3 the effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
