AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR DONNA TOWNER, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would defeat its
2 purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for
3 Donna Towner an employee of the trial court, therefore it is
4 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the imme-
5 diate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regula-
2 tion to the contrary, the trial court shall establish a sick leave bank
3 for Donna Towner, an employee of the trial court. Any employee
4 of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
5 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Donna
6 Towner. Whenever Donna Towner terminates employment with
7 the trial court or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the
8 balance of the sick leave time shall be transferred to the trial court
9 paid leave bank.
