## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TOWN OF TYNGSBOROUGH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 53 of Chapter 44 of the  
2 General Laws, the town of Tyngsborough may establish and main-  
3 tain a separate account known as the Recreation Fields Fund. The  
4 town treasurer shall keep the fund separate and apart from all other  
5 monies of the town and shall deposit into the account 10 per cent of  
6 field usage fees for the use of school and town fields annually.

7 The treasurer may invest these funds in the manner prescribed in  
8 Section 54 and 55 of said Chapter 44. The town and the Tyngsbor-  
9 ough school district may expend the principal and income from the  
10 fund for non-routine maintenance of elementary school fields and  
11 Pierce Field and for the replacement of the artificial surface of  
12 Pierce Field.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
