

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 4163

By Mr. Peterson of Grafton, petition of George N. Peterson, Jr., that the Department of Revenue be authorized to establish a sick leave bank for Linda M. Supernor, an employee of said department. Public Service.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR LINDA M. SUPERNOR, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

1     *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave  
3 bank for a certain employee of the department of revenue, there-  
4 fore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for  
5 the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule or regula-  
2 tion to the contrary, the department of revenue shall establish a  
3 sick leave bank for Linda M. Supernor, an employee of said  
4 department. Any employee of said department may voluntarily  
5 contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick  
6 leave bank for use by said Linda M. Supernor. Whenever said  
7 Linda M. Supernor terminates employment with said department  
8 or request to dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of the sick  
9 leave time shall be transferred to the department of revenue paid  
10 leave bank.
