

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 4165

By Representative Hall of Westford and Senator Panagiotakos, joint petition of Geoffrey D. Hall and Steven C. Panagiotakos (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the transfer of a portion of conservation land in the town of Westford to the council on aging for expansion of the Cameron Senior Center of said town. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT TO TRANSFER THE CARE AND CUSTODY OF A PORTION OF CAMERON SCHOOL CONSERVATION LAND FROM THE CONSERVATION COMMISSION TO THE COUNCIL ON AGING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Westford may transfer a certain parcel  
2 of land from the care, custody and control of the conservation com-  
3 mission to the council on aging for the expansion of the Cameron  
4 Senior Center. Said parcel is shown as Parcel A on a plan of land  
5 entitled Plan of Land in Westford, MA. Prepared for Westford Con-  
6 servation Commission dated August 14, 1991 by Richard L.  
7 McGlinchey.

1 SECTION 2. The transfer of land authorized in Section 1 shall be  
2 conditioned on the transfer by the board of selectmen to the conser-  
3 vation commission of a parcel of land entitled "Plan of Land in  
4 Forge Village, Westford, Mass. Belonging to Abbot Worsted Com-  
5 pany" dated January 31, 1956 drawn by Frederick Burne recorded at  
6 the Middlesex North District Registry of Deeds at Book of Plans 87,  
7 Plan 59A and the transfer by the tax possession sale committee to  
8 the conservation commission of a certain parcel of land shown as  
9 Lot 1 on a plan of land entitled "Plans of Land in Brookside, West-  
10 ford, Mass" dated February 1905 drawn by Smith and Brooks, Civil  
11 Engineering recorded at the Middlesex North District Registry of  
12 Deeds at Book of Plans 21, Plan 49A.

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
