## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO AN ADDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSE IN THE CITY OF SALEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 17 of  
2 chapter 138 of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the City  
3 of Salem may issue an annual full time license for the sale of all  
4 alcohol beverages to be drunk on the premises under section 12 of  
5 said Chapter 138 to New Boston Ventures, LLC for a restaurant to  
6 be located at 50 St. Peter Street in Salem, Massachusetts. The  
7 license shall be subject to said Chapter 138, except section 17; pro-  
8 vided however, that the licensing authority shall not approve the  
9 transfer of the license to any location other than 50 St. Peter Street in  
10 Salem, Massachusetts.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
