

HOUSE No. 4225

By Mr. Wallace of Boston, petition of Brian P. Wallace for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Karen Byrnes, an employee of the Department of Conservation and Recreation. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR KAREN BYRNES, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION AND RECREATION.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain
3 employee of the department of conservation and recreation, there-
4 fore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for
5 the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule, or regulation
2 to the contrary, the department of conservation and recreation
3 shall establish a sick leave bank for Karen Byrnes, and employee
4 of the department. Any employee of the department may volun-
5 tarily contribute one or more sick, personal or vacation days to the
6 sick leave bank for use by Karen Byrnes. Whenever Karen Byrnes
7 terminates employment with the department or requests to dis-
8 solve the sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave time shall
9 be transferred to the department of conservation and recreation
10 sick leave bank.
