By Mr. Wallace of Boston, petition of Brian P. Wallace and Stephen Stat Smith relative to the eligibility of the sons of William Hayhurst, a deceased fire fighter of the city of Boston, for appointment to the fire department of said city. Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SONS OF WILLIAM HAYHURST, A DECEASED FIRE-FIGHTER FROM THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the sons of William
3 Hayhurst, a deceased firefighter in the City of Boston, shall be
4 eligible for original appointment to the Boston Fire Department and
5 shall be considered survivors pursuant to Section 26 of Chapter 31
6 of the Massachusetts General Laws. In order to have their names so
7 certified, said descendants must first pass the written and physical
8 examinations required of all candidates for entrance to the fire
9 service.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
