

HOUSE No. 4275

By Mr. Keenan of Salem, petition of John D. Keenan (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to authorize the city of Salem to issue an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises to New Boston Ventures, LLC. Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SALEM TO ISSUE ADDITIONAL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 17 of Chapter 138 of the
2 General Laws, the licensing authority of the city of Salem may grant
3 1 additional license for the sale of all alcohol beverages to be drunk
4 on the premises under Section 12 of said Chapter 138 to New
5 Boston Ventures, LLC, for a restaurant located at 50 St. Peter Street
6 in Salem. The license shall be subject to all of said Chapter 138
7 except section 17.

8 Notwithstanding any general or special law, or any rule or regula-
9 tion to the contrary, the local alcohol licensing authority shall not
10 approve the transfer of said license to any other location. Said
11 license may be granted by the local alcohol licensing authority at the
12 same location if an applicant for said license files with said authority
13 a letter in writing from the department of revenue indicating that
14 said license is in good standing with said department and that any
15 and all applicable taxes have been paid. If the license granted under
16 this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, such license
17 shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges
18 and restrictions pertaining thereto, to the local alcohol licensing
19 authority.

20 Notwithstanding Section 17 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws,
21 or any other general of special law to the contrary, the local alcohol
22 licensing authority may then grant the license to a new applicant at

23 the same location and under the same conditions as specified in the
24 preceding paragraph.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
