By Mr. Guyer of Dalton, petition of Denis E. Guyer for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for William Ryan, an employee of the Department of Correction in the sheriff's department of Berkshire County. Public Service.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR A CERTAIN EMPLOYEE OF THE BERKSHIRE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave
3 bank for a certain employee of the department of correction,
4 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary
5 for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regula-
2 tion to the contrary, the department of correction shall establish a
3 sick leave bank for William Ryan, an employee of the department.
4 Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or
5 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use
6 by William Ryan. Whenever William Ryan terminates employ-
7 ment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave
8 bank, the balance of the sick leave time shall be transferred to the
9 extended illness leave bank.
