By Mr. Murphy of Burlington, petition of Charles A. Murphy that the Department of Public Health be authorized to establish a sick leave bank for Lynda Graham-Meho, an employee of said department. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR LYNDA GRAHAM-MEHO,
AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave
3 bank for a certain employee of the department of public health,
4 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary
5 for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regula-
2 tion to the contrary, the department of public health shall establish
3 a sick leave bank for Lynda Graham-Meho, an employee of the
4 department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily
5 contribute 1 or more of his sick, personal or vacation days to the
6 sick leave bank for use by Lynda Graham-Meho. Whenever Lynda
7 Graham-Meho terminates employment with the department or
8 requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance shall be trans-
9 ferred to the extended illness leave bank.
