### AN ACT RELATIVE TO SALES AND EXCISE TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR DISABLED VETERANS.

1     *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2     defeat its purpose, which is to allow disabled veterans access to  
3     sales and excise tax exemptions, therefore it is hereby declared to  
4     be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of  
5     the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     Section 1 of Chapter 60A of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2     the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line  
3     101, after the word “disabled” the following words:— ; and who  
4     qualify for and are therefore entitled to display thereon the dis-  
5     tinctive number plates authorized by Section 2 Chapter 90.

6     Section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in  
7     the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in

8 lines 312 and 313, the words “and has been issued a disabled vet-  
9 eran number plate under Section 2 of said Chapter 90’ and  
10 inserting in place thereof the following words:— ; and who  
11 qualify for and are therefore entitled to display thereon the dis-  
12 tinctive number plates authorized by Section 2 Chapter 90.
