AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of Class B of Section 31 of Chapter
2 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,
3 shall be amended by inserting the following item:—
4 (9) Kratom (*Mitragyna speciosa*), or any salt, compound, deriva-
5 tive, or preparation of kratom, and any salt, compound, derivative, or
6 preparation thereof which is chemically equivalent or identical with
7 kratom.

1 SECTION 2. Subsection (e) of Class C of Section 31 of Chapter
2 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,
3 shall be amended by inserting the following items:—
4 (16) *Salvia Divinorum*;
5 (17) *Salvinorin A*;
6 (18) *Catha Edulis*.

1 SECTION 3. Subsection (12) of the definition of “Drug parapher-
2 nalia” under Section 1 of Chapter 94C of the General Laws, as
3 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, shall be amended by adding
4 the following items:—
5 (p) blunt wrappers;
6 (q) rose bud smoking pipes.
