AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL FUND IN THE TOWN OF MILLIS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 53 of
2 Chapter 44 of the General Laws or any other special or general law
3 to the contrary, the Town of Millis may establish a special account to
4 be known as the Crestview Drive/Klifford Circle Public Way Layout
5 Fund. There shall be credited to said fund all rent or other monies
6 received by the Town from the lease of a portion of town owned
7 land on Assessor's map number 52, parcels 11, 12, 15, 19 and for a
8 proposed cellular antennae site. Any interest earned on the account
9 shall be credited to and become part of said fund.

1 SECTION 2. The amounts credited to said fund may, without fur-
2 ther appropriation by the town, be expended by the Board of
3 Selectmen only for the costs or payment of indebtedness incurred
4 under chapter 44, section 7 of the General Laws or any other general
5 or special law for plans for the layout of Crestview Drive and Klif-
6 ford Circle as public ways and/or for the improvement of Crestview
7 Drive and Klifford Circle, provided that no payment or borrowing
8 for the improvement of said roads shall be made until they are laid
9 out and accepted as public ways pursuant to chapter 82, sections 21-
10 24 of the General Laws. Said costs shall include, but not be limited

11 to, paving and reconstruction of the road surfaces and appurte-
12 nances, the preparation of street acceptance plans and as-built plans,
13 the setting and installation of bounds, and the acquisition of ease-
14 ments.

1 SECTION 3. Any moneys credited to said fund that the Board of
2 Selectmen determines are not needed for the costs described in
3 section 2 of this act shall be deposited into the town treasury.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
