AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR SAMUEL PILL, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a
3 certain employee of the trial court, therefore it is hereby declared to
4 be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of
5 the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to
2 the contrary, the trial court shall establish a sick leave bank for
3 Samuel Pill, an employee of the trial court. Any employer of the trial
4 court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more of his sick, personal or
5 vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Samuel Pill. When-
6 ever Samuel Pill terminates employment with the trial court or
7 requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of sick leave
8 shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank.
