AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR JESSE GOGUEN.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a
3 certain employee of the department of correction, therefore it is
4 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the imme-
5 diate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation
2 to the contrary, the department of correction shall establish a sick
3 leave bank for Jesse Goguen, an employee of the department of cor-
4 rection. Any employee of that department may voluntarily contribute
5 1 or more of his sick, personal or vacation days to said sick leave
6 bank for use by Jesse Goguen. Whenever Jesse Goguen terminates
7 employment with the department of correction or requests to dis-
8 solve the sick leave bank established by this act, the balance of the
9 sick leave time remaining in the sick leave bank shall be transferred
10 to the extended illness leave bank.
