

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 4762

By Mr. Smith of Everett, petition of Stephen Stat Smith (with the approval of the mayor, board of aldermen and city council) relative to the nomination and election of a charter commission in the city of Everett. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CITY OF EVERETT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Everett shall nominate and elect a  
2 Charter Commission for the purposes of revising and amending its  
3 charter, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 43B of the  
4 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The state secretary shall cause the following ques-  
2 tion to be placed on the official ballot to be used in the city of  
3 Everett at the next biennial municipal election in the year 2009:—  
4 “Shall the city of Everett nominate and elect a Charter Commis-  
5 sion in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 43B of the  
6 General Laws of Massachusetts?”  
7 If a majority of votes are cast in the affirmative, then this act shall  
8 take effect, but not otherwise.

1 SECTION 3. This Charter Commission is to be nominated and  
2 elected at the next biennial election to be held in 2009.
