AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR DAVID CATANZARO, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT.

1     *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave  
3 bank for a certain employee of the trial court department, there-  
4 fore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for  
5 the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regula-  
2 tion to the contrary, the trial court shall establish a sick leave bank  
3 for David Catanzaro, an employee of the trial court. An employee  
4 of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, per-  
5 sonal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by David  
6 Catanzaro. Whenever David Catanzaro terminates employment  
7 with the trial court or request to dissolve the sick leave bank, the  
8 balance of the sick leave time shall be transferred to the trial court  
9 paid sick leave bank.
