AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR MATTHEW DICICCO, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat  
2 its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a  
3 certain employee of the department of corrections, therefore it is  
4 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the im-  
5 mediate preservation of the public convenience

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule  
2 or regulation to the contrary, the department of corrections shall  
3 establish a sick leave bank for Matthew DiCicco, an employee of the  
4 department of corrections. Any employee of the department may  
5 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to  
6 the sick leave bank for use by Matthew DiCicco. Whenever  
7 Matthew DiCicco terminates employment with the trial court or  
8 request to dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave  
9 time shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
