AN ACT RELATIVE TO PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law, rule  
2 or regulation to the contrary, all public safety employees of the  
3 Commonwealth or any municipality, and any emergency medical  
4 technicians, including those employed by a private organization or  
5 unit, shall submit to a random drug and alcohol testing program for  
6 those employees, which meets standards promulgated by the secre-  
7 tary of the executive office of public safety and security.
