AN ACT RELATIVE TO JOSEPH BOUDREAU'S STATE POLICE PENSION.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose which is to forthwith make certain pension funds
3 available, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,
4 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public conve-
5 nience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2 state board of retirement shall pay a member survivor allowance
3 to Tavesri-Jantima Boudreau, widow of Joseph R. Joseph R. J.
4 Boudreau, a retired state police officer, effective on the date of his
5 death February 2, 2007 equal to the amount she would have
6 received if he had named her as his beneficiary.
