AN ACT EXEMPTING RICHARD CORCORAN AND KAZIMIERZ R. PIORKOWSKI, JR. FROM THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT AS A FIREFIGHTER IN THE TOWN OF WESTWOOD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Sections 58, 61A and 61B of
2 Chapter 31 of the General Laws, or any other general or special law
3 to the contrary, Richard Corcoran of the town of Mendon and Kaz-
4 imierz R. Piorkowski, Jr. of the town of Millis may have their names
5 certified for original appointment to the position of firefighter in the
6 town of Westwood, notwithstanding having reached the age of 32
7 before taking any civil service examination in connection with such
8 appointment. In all other respects, Richard Corcoran and Kazimierz
9 R. Piorkowski, Jr. shall be eligible for appointment to the position of
10 firefighter in the town of Westwood only insofar as they qualify and
11 are selected for employment under Chapter 31, any regulations of
12 the civil service commission and any lawful hiring practices of the
13 town of Westwood.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
