## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Eight.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR MARYAN LABAIRE, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

1     *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat  
2 its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a  
3 certain employee of the Department of Children and Families, there-  
4 fore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for  
5 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to  
2 the contrary, the department of children and families shall establish a  
3 sick leave bank for Maryan Labaire, an employee of said depart-  
4 ment. Any employee of said department may voluntarily  
5 contribute 1 or more of his/her sick, personal or vacation days to  
6 said sick leave bank for use by said Maryan Labaire. Whenever said  
7 Maryan Labaire terminates employment with said department or  
8 requests to dissolve said sick leave bank, the balance of the sick  
9 leave time shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
