AN ACT TO FREEZE TOLL INCREASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. (a) The power of the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority
2 to fix and revise tolls, as established in Subsections (i) and (j) of
3 Section 4 and Section 10 of Chapter 81A of the General Laws, as
4 appearing, shall be suspended from the date of this act until
5 December 31, 2009 or until comprehensive transportation reform
6 legislation is passed by the Legislature, if that occurs prior to
7 December 31, 2009.
