To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in General Court assembled:

The undersigned legislators and/or citizens respectfully petition for the passage of the accompanying bill:
An Act Relative to False Criminal Complaints.

Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 38 the following section:—

Section 38A. Any person found to have deliberately brought a false charge in seeking a criminal complaint shall make restitution to the person accused for any costs, lost wages and attorneys' fees and may be punished by a fine of one hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.
