

SENATE NO. 329

AN ACT CHANGING THE MAXIMUM REQUIRED AGE FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 76 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 1 to 2, the words “and maximum ages established for
3 school attendance by the board of education” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- age
4 established for school attendance by the board of education and the age of 18.

5 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall apply to all cities, towns, and regional school districts, notwithstanding
6 section 27C of chapter 29, and without regard to any acceptance or appropriation by a city, town or
7 regional school district or to any appropriation by the general court.
