AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR CAPITAL EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT IN VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AS PART OF STATE AID TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2. Chapter 70 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by striking the definition of “extraordinary maintenance allotment” in lines 131-135
3 and inserting in place thereof a new definition: - “Extraordinary maintenance allotment,” the amount
4 allotted within a district’s foundation budget for extraordinary maintenance costs and to provide for
5 modernization and replacement of capital equipment in vocational schools in any fiscal year. The
6 extraordinary maintenance allotment shall be two thousand, two hundred dollars multiplied by the sum
7 of foundation teaching staff and the foundation support staff. The capital equipment replacement
8 allotment shall be five hundred dollars multiplied by the foundation vocational enrollment.
