

# SENATE NO. 359

## **AN ACT** RELATIVE TO STUDENT TUTORS FOR THE MCAS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1B of chapter 69, as appearing in the 2000 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the ninth paragraph the following paragraph:-

3 Any high school student with at least a 3.0 grade point average in the student's senior  
4 year shall, with the consent of the school's principal and a recommendation of a teacher, be  
5 allowed to commit three hours a week to tutoring students in preparation for the MCAS tests,  
6 and upon completion of tutoring service for one year, be entitled to a tuition credit of \$500.00, if  
7 the student matriculates to a public state college or university.

8 The funds for tuition credit shall come from appropriations for MCAS tutors and shall  
9 be contingent upon their availability.
