

# SENATE NO. 568

## **AN ACT** PROVIDING CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS FROM CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR INSURANCE AGENTS BASED ON AGE AND YEARS OF LICENSING

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (I) of section 177E of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following clause:-

3 (4) Persons holding a license for fifteen (15) years and who are age (62) at the time of renewal.

4 SECTION 2. The Division of Insurance shall exempt agents who have been licensed for 15 years or  
5 more and who have attained 62 years of age beginning January 1, 2000.
