AN ACT REQUIRING PHOTOGRAPHS ON PROTECTIVE ORDERS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 209A, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word “order.”, in line 3, the following 2 sentences:- Whenever
3 an order is made permanent, the court shall cause a color photograph of the defendant, or a color
4 copy thereof, to be affixed to each certified copy transmitted pursuant to section 7. The
5 photograph shall be taken by the probation department during any appearance by the defendant
6 related to the issuance of the order.
