

SENATE NO. 851

AN ACT TO PERMIT INDEPENDENT ENFORCEMENT OF RESTITUTION ORDERS IN CRIMINAL CASES

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 92 of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following paragraph:-

3 Any order of restitution in a criminal case that has not been satisfied or revoked, whether or not
4 originally imposed as a condition of probation, shall in the court's discretion be separately
5 enforceable pursuant to section 1 of chapter 279 even after the defendant has been discharged
6 from probation or after the defendant's probation has been revoked and the defendant
7 committed.
