AN ACT ON APPELLATE JURISDICTION

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 18 of chapter 240 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 3 and 4, inclusive, the words "supreme judicial
3 court" and inserting in place thereof the words: - appeals court or, subject to the provisions of section
4 ten of chapter two hundred and eleven A, to the full court of the supreme judicial court,

5 SECTION 2. Section 28 of chapter 278 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
6 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 3 the words "supreme judicial court" and inserting in
7 place thereof the words: - appeals court or, subject to the provisions of section ten of chapter two
8 hundred and eleven A, to the full court of the supreme judicial court.

9 SECTION 3. Section 28E of chapter 278 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
10 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 9 and 10 the words "supreme judicial court" and

- 11 inserting in place thereof the words: - appeals court or, subject to the provisions of section ten of
- 12 chapter two hundred and eleven A, to the full court of the supreme judicial court
