

SENATE NO. 992

AN ACT TO EXPAND CORI CHECKS BY SCHOOL OFFICIALS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 38R of Chapter 71 of the General Laws as appearing in the most recent edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:
3 Further said school committee, superintendent or principal must seek cooperation from any individual
4 described here in as having direct and unmonitored contact with children, that said school committee,
5 superintendent or principal has reasonable belief has a background in another jurisdiction, for the
6 purpose of receiving record information from the other jurisdiction. If the School official believes the
7 individual came from another state, they shall with the cooperation of that individual seek criminal
8 history record information from the other state provided the laws of that state allow such access with
9 the individuals cooperation.
