

SENATE NO. 1015

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR RECIPROCAL SERVICE FOR RESTRAINING ORDERS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Secretary of Public Safety and the Secretary of Administration and Finance
2 are hereby authorized and directed to design a multi-state compact providing for the reciprocal
3 service by and between the signatory states of the orders issued pursuant to those provided for
4 in Chapter 209A of the General Laws, and similar orders issued in accordance with the laws of
5 signatory states to said compact; provided further, that said Secretaries are authorized and
6 directed to initiate negotiations with potential signatory states, including but not limited to New
7 Hampshire, Maine, Connecticut, Rhode Island and New York; provided further that any said
8 compact shall at a minimum provide for the service of such orders without cost to the issuing
9 state, and shall require ratification by the Legislature and Governor of any signatory state.
