

SENATE NO. 1026

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMMISSION OF A CRIME WHILE IN POSSESSION OF A POLICE SCANNER

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 266 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after section 49 the following section:-

- 3 Section 49A. Whoever, while in the commission of a crime, knowingly has in their possession a
- 4 police scanner with the intent to use or employ said scanner to aid in the commission of such
- 5 crime shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than ten years or by a
- 6 fine of not more than one thousand dollars and imprisonment in jail for not more than two and
- 7 one-half years.
