

SENATE NO. 1455

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT BOARD TO PAY A CERTAIN RETIREMENT BENEFIT TO THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF JOHN O'NEIL

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of this individual's convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law, rule or regulation to
2 the contrary, the state employees' retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to pay
3 Caryl H. O'Neil, the surviving spouse of John O'Neil, a former employee at Mount Wachusett
4 Community College, a pension equal to that which she would receive had section 12 of chapter
5 32 of the General Laws, as currently in effect, been in effect at the time of retirement of said
6 John O'Neil and at said time John O'Neil had chosen option (c) as set forth in said section 12 of
7 said section 32. Said payments shall become effective on the first payment date after the
8 effective date of this act and shall not be retroactive.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
