

SENATE NO. 1494

AN ACT RELATIVE TO SURVIVOR ALLOWANCE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 12(2)I of Chapter 32, of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 105 the words “and may not choose another option” and
3 inserting in place thereof the words “or may choose an alternate beneficiary, provided such alternate
4 beneficiary is physically or mentally incapacitated from earning on the date of death of the original
5 beneficiary.

6 SECTION 2. Section 12(2)ii of Chapter 32, of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000 Official
7 Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the words “under age eighteen”, in line 139, the words
8 “unless such child is over age eighteen and physically or mentally incapacitated from earning, then
9 such child shall continue to receive such allowance.
