

SENATE NO. 1525

AN ACT REGULATING CERTAIN INSURANCE BENEFITS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE TOWN OF EASTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 32B of the General Laws or any other general or special law to
2 the contrary, elected officials of the town of Easton who receive a stipend shall not be eligible for
3 participation in the town's contributory health and life insurance plans, but officials who were elected
4 before May 1, 2006 and currently participate in those plans shall be eligible to continue to participate
5 until the end of their current terms at the same rate of contribution as non-union employees. Elected
6 officials who receive a stipend shall remain eligible to participate in the plans if they pay 100 per cent
7 of the cost of their participation to the town, plus any administrative costs that may be assessed by the
8 board of selectmen.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
