

SENATE NO. 1529

AN ACT PERMITTING THE REINSTATEMENT OF ROGER B. CATALDO TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWICK

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Roger B. Cataldo, a retired
2 patrolman of the police department of the town of Southwick may be reinstated in such a position for a
3 period of 5 years until he reaches the age of 70, provided, that he is mentally and physically capable of
4 performing the duties of such position. Roger B. Cataldo shall, at the town's expense, be examined by
5 an impartial physician designated by the town to determine such capability. No further deductions
6 shall be made from his regular compensation under chapter 32 of the General Laws for service
7 subsequent to December 31, 2002 and upon retirement he shall receive a superannuation retirement
8 allowance equal to that which was entitled to receive as of December 31, 2002.
