

SENATE NO. 1542

AN ACT CONCERNING RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000 Official
2 Edition, is amended in subsection 2 (g) Group 4 in line 307 by deleting the period at the end of the
3 sentence and adding:
4 State medical Examiner, Chief Medical Examiner, Assistant Chief Medical Examiner, Associate
5 Chief Medical Examiner, State/ Forensic Pathologists, but the State Medical Examiner, Chief Medical
6 Examiner, Associate Chief Medical Examiner, State/ Forensic Pathologists shall have served or will be
7 required to serve for a period of ten (10) years in one or more of these positions before becoming
8 eligible for benefits under this section.
