

SENATE NO. 1596

AN ACT RELATIVE TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING RIGHTS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Commonwealth
2 and its political subdivisions may not employ the use of Global Position System technology, or
3 other similar technology, to monitor or track employees of the Commonwealth or its political
4 subdivisions, unless the implementation and terms of use of such technology is mutually agreed
5 to in a collective bargaining agreement. In the absence of a collective bargaining agreement, the
6 implementation and use of such technology shall be subject to the provision sections 52 to 56,
7 inclusive, of Chapter 7 of the General Laws.
