

SENATE NO. 1860

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR FURNISHING A SUMMARY OF THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST LAWS TO STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 23 of Chapter 268A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (f) and inserting in place thereof the following
3 paragraph:-

4 (f) Every state, county and municipal employee shall, within 30 days of becoming such an employee,
5 be furnished with a summary of chapter 268A prepared or approved by the commission and sign a
6 written acknowledgment that he has been provided with such a summary. Municipal employees shall
7 be furnished the summary by, and file such an acknowledgment with, the city or town clerk.
8 Appointed state and county employees shall be furnished the summary by, and file such an
9 acknowledgment with, such employee's appointing authority or his designee. Elected state and county
10 employees shall be furnished the summary by, and file such an acknowledgment with, the
11 commission.

12 SECTION 2. Every state, county and municipal employee who, on the effective date of this act, is
13 such an employee shall, within 90 days of the effective date of this act, be furnished with, and sign and

14 file a written acknowledgment that he has been provided, a summary of chapter 268A prepared or
15 approved by the commission, as provided in paragraph (f) of section 23 of said chapter 268A as
16 amended by section 1 of this act.
