

# SENATE NO. 2099

## **AN ACT** DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF DOVER AS THE GOVERNOR FRANCIS W. SARGENT BRIDGE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The bridge on Chestnut Street spanning the Charles River, bridge number D-10-  
2 005, in the town of Dover shall be designated and known as the Governor Francis W. Sargent  
3 Bridge, in honor of his many years of service to the citizens of the Commonwealth. The  
4 department of highways shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in  
5 compliance with the standards of the department.
