

SENATE NO. 2146

AN ACT CONCERNING THE WORLD WAR II BONUS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other general or special law, rule or
2 regulation to the contrary, a person shall qualify for the bonus created by chapter 731 of the acts
3 of 1945 if he served in the armed forces of the United States between September 16, 1940 and
4 July 25, 1947, has been awarded a world war two victory medal, and has received a discharge or
5 release, other than a dishonorable one, from such service.
