

SENATE, No. 2206

AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN PUBLIC DEFENDERS CREDITABLE RETIREMENT SERVICE TIME FOR SERVICE AS AN EMPLOYEE OF ROXBURY DEFENDERS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the
2 state retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to credit the following employees of the
3 Committee for Public Counsel Services creditable service for the years of their employment
4 with the Roxbury Defenders Committee, Inc, for the purpose of determining their retirement
5 allowance pursuant to section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws: Yolanda Acevedo, JoAnn
6 Donovan, William Hill, Jr., Tauheedah Shakur, Mary Ann Thomas, Rosemary Williams-Hill
7 and Antoinette DaGraca; provided, however, they shall pay into the annuity savings fund of the
8 state retirement fund, in one sum or installments, upon such terms and conditions as the board
9 may prescribe, an amount equal to that which would have been withheld as regular deductions
10 from their regular compensation for such previous service, plus interest.
